**Certification of Averages**

The Captain certifies that the average listed is the highest from last Winter season, based on 21 or more games. In the event of no average, the listed average is based on the current season as average at time of bowling.

# Read the information given below CAREFULLY!

1. Bowlers are permitted to bowl more than once. In Singles, may only collect once in the top five.
2. If there is a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place prize money, first and second place prize money will be divided equally.
3. Team handicap based on 80% of 1150 scratch. Singles handicap is based on 80% of 230. Doubles handicap is based on 80% of 460.
4. Entrants will use their highest USBC final certified official book average based on minimum of 21 games for the 19-20 season. If no average last year, use USBC average this year at time of bowling provided you have 21 games or more bowled.
5. 10-pin rule in effect at time of bowling. If your average is 10 pins higher on the day you bowl., then you must use the higher average.
6. Sport bowling members or challenge league must comply with the requirements outlined in chapter 5 (USBC sport bowling) of the USBC rule book.
7. Rule 202a – the scale found on page 77 of the 2020-2021 USBC playing rule book will be used to adjust Sport Bowling League averages upward, as required, for use in standard competition.
8. Rule 202d will apply in its entirety. Sport league average adjustment.
9. A sport league average adjustment must be reported to tournament official at check-in table prior to bowling. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
10. Rule 300c will apply in this entirety (tournament eligibility).
11. Rule 313 will apply in this entirety (tournament eligibility).
12. Rule 308 – 100% of all the prize money will be returned to entrants.
13. Rule 314 – after any entry has been received, and the dates assigned by tournament management are not refused before preparation of the schedule, the entry fee cannot be refunded.
14. Rule 315b – in order to place more than once in the top 10 in the team prize for positions standings, at least two players in the line up must be different.
15. Rule 319a 1, 3, and 4 will apply.
16. Rule 319c – the average of a bowler may be adjusted upward before entrant bowls. If the assigned average is not accepted bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded.
17. Rules 319d, 391e, 321, 322a, 324b, and 325 will apply.
18. If USBC, your local association, or any tournament has re-rated your average, you must use the re-rated average. If you have been barred or disqualified, or you refused a re-rate, you must report the fact to the tournament official at time of check in, prior to bowling, for a possible re-rate in this tournament. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. This rule includes reporting of all certified and uncertified tournaments, including those using a modified format of American Ten Pins (example: 9 pin tap).
19. If you have in the past 12 months or are currently in a position to win \$600.00 or more in any tournament (no tap included), you must report this fact to tournament official at check-in prior to bowling. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
20. Prize money will not be paid until requested verification forms are completely filled out, signed by league and association secretaries and returned. Failure to return verification forms in the allowed time will result in disqualification.
21. Should any rule questions or infractions occur other than the rules stated on the entry form, the official USBC tournament playing rules book for 2020-21 will be enforced.
22. Rule 303 will apply in its entirety. Director reserves the right to refuse any entry.
23. Tournament management reserves the right to re-rate entrants prior to bowling.
24. Must check in half hour before squad time.
25. Only two current PBA members per team.

The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Hank Marino Tournament, its officers, and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency, or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties, or other causes beyond control of the Hank Marino Tournament.
